

Type B. Mahogany 20-in. decks with coaming, mahogany rails, seats and thwarts. Hardwood keel. Floor rack included. Outside stems extra.

The invisible sponson canoe is a marked improvement over the old style sponson with the pronounced bulge at the rail line. The construction is the same, but the shape has been changed so that the air chamber is not quite as thick in any one place, but carries down around the bilge more and conforms to the sides of the canoe in a graceful curve. Buoyancy is remarkable, as shown in the accompanying picture. When a canoe will carry a load as the one in this picture shows it sure is sturdy in the water. The invisible sponson is unhesitatingly offered for use in all waters. This type of sponson is built underneath the outside canvas and may be repaired or recanvased at very small expense, compaired with the old type of sponson construction.

Materials used include airplane spruce for keel, longitudinal frames and cockpit coaming: especially developed marine laminated wood in the bow, stern, and cross-sections: closely woven canvas of double thread construction for the hull, and regular government specification airplane wing dope, which when painted onto the hull fabric with an ordinary paint brush, completely waterproofs the material, shrinks and tightens it into a glove-like fit, freeing it of the wrinkles which are usually the bane of the amateur boat builder's existence, and toughening it with something resembling rhinocerous hide in the same manner that it strengthens airplane wings for the terrific strain they must bear. Every piece of material which goes in the craft is numbered, so that directions for assembling may be easily followed.

"Eskimo" Kyaks are patterned fundamentally after the Eskimo type boat, and with the adaptation of airplane material in much of their construction, they are the strongest for their weight and size which can be produced. Ideally adapted to shallow water fishing or to carry the duck hunter and his luggage. "Eskimo" Kyaks are made of heavier material than in the past.


