

How Skowhegan Canoes Are Built



Interior View

The very best of materials in the hands of expert Down East Boat Builders result in the unexcelled beauty, safety, lightness and durability that characterize all Skowhegan canoes.

The ribs are made of white cedar and are 5-16" thick, $2\frac{1}{4}$ " wide, and spaced $1\frac{1}{4}$ " apart. The finest quality, straight grained cedar planking, 5-32" thick, is smooth laid in long lengths with tight joints. Thwarts, deck and seats are made of hardwood or mahogany as desired—seats caned—thwarts bolted close to open gunwales. Stem and keel are made of oak, the keel, $\frac{7}{8}$ " deep, running full length of canoe and well under bangplates.

All Skowhegan canoes are copper fastened throughout and are covered with best quality No. 8 extra heavy canvas, properly waterproofed, and all trace of texture removed by a special hard drying filler. Woodwork, inside of natural finish, outside finished in color with high grade spar varnish.

SKOWHEGAN CANOES ARE MADE IN TWO STYLES:

- Style I—Hardwood, 20-inch decks, open spruce gunwales, hardwood seat frames and thwarts, oak keel.
- Style II-—Mahogany, 20-inch decks, with coaming, mahogany rails, seats, thwarts, oak keel. Floor rack included.

It is the one canoe designed for camp purposes where beauty is combined with ruggedness and is built to meet the camp demand for attractive style and fine finish at reasonable cost. The fullness at bow and stern found in the "Skowhegan" is also built into this model, making it safer for use by boys and girls or in adult pleasure camps. Best quality No. 8 extra heavy canvas is used in this model and the same graceful lines which characterize the more expensive Skowhegan canoes are also found in the "Camp Special." Finished in spruce, it is very attractive.



This boat was designed for Speed, Comfort, and Seaworthiness. It has two rowing seats and a stern seat; it is equipped with 2 pairs Brass Oarlocks. This boat has a wide flat bottom which makes it very steady. This boat is designed especially for the use of light motors, but is very easy to row. Boat is built with smooth seam of cedar planking, fastened with brass screws, oak or ash ribs, oak gunwales, hardwood stem and keel. Finished with four coats of best grade paint to stand extreme service in rough water. Equally good as a tender with outboard motor or for ordinary use as a pleasure boat. Inside is painted grey, outside dark green or dark brown. Included with boat are floor rack, one pair oarlocks, two pairs oarlock sockets, two rowing seats, bow and stern seats. Oars, plain ash—\$3.50; spruce—\$5.32.

It will fit any model; takes less than 30 seconds to attach, and can be used with any make of engine. The "Jiffy" sets firmly across the canoe just in back of the seat, in a position exceptionally convenient for starting and handling. With the "Jiffy" Bracket, no special extension shaft is necessary. It carries any standard make of motor close enough to the water so that the cooling system functions perfectly. This feature also lowers the center of gravity and does away with any tendency toward top-heaviness and crankiness. Because the "Jiffy" Bracket is adjustable and can be moved forward or backward, as the loading of your canoe requires, you scoot along on an even keel and not with your bow in the air. A motor attachment plate that can be quickly and easily reversed makes it possible to use your motor on whichever side of the canoe is most convenient. With the "Jiffy" your motor can be tipped and swung just as easily and conveniently as is the case where it is

attached to the square stern boat. An outboard-equipped canoe is faster and allows you to cover more territory. It handles more easily and better, particularly in swift water. On portages the advantages of the canoe with a "Jiffy" outboard equipment over the square stern boat are obvious. The "Jiffy" Bracket can be stowed away in a small space and weighs only 7 lbs. 
