CONSTRUCTION

All Morris Canoes are constructed with canvas cover. The boat is ribbed, then planked smooth and tight with very light material, which is all that is required when canvas is used for the outside surface. A water-proof coating is applied to the wood before the canvas is put on. The canvas is then drawn over the planking perfectly smooth and tight. The canvas is then filled with the Morris Composition, which gives it the most even and durable surface, leaving no trace of the grain of the canvas. This surface is then finished in color and varnish, producing a finish equal to that of a fine carriage. The inside of the boat and all wood parts are finished in natural wood and varnished.

Any further information regarding any point not fully understood will be cheerfully given.

The Morris Canoes are known generally as a standard article which contains, in each, in every way, the same quality of material and workmanship, and are strictly guaranteed to prove of exceptionally good value and satisfactory.

I wish to state that the prices herein quoted are the lowest retail prices at which these goods can be produced, and warrant perfect construction and unequalled value.

The Morris Canoe Plant is located in the town of Veazie, four miles above Bangor, on the Penobscot River, connected with Bangor by street and steam cars.

Veazie is a shipping point on the Maine Central R. R.

IMPORTANT

Striping must be done before the canoe has its final coat of composition and requires six to eight days seasoning before shipment is made. **Lettering** can be done on canoes that are finished, within a period of 24 hours, but not with as good results as when more time is allowed.

The colors of canoes generally on hand are:—Deep Red, Light, Medium and Dark Green, Light and Dark Olive. There will be no fancy painting, striping or lettering on canoes except done to order. Canoes will be finished in any special color possible if sample of same is furnished and ample time is allowed for finishing, which in most cases, requires 10 days. When ordering for immediate shipment, please mention if you will allow option on color.

Extras: For lettering, the most appropriate size and style is 1 1-2 in. block letters which will be put on to order at 8 cts. per letter, done in gold with double shading. For striping the entire length of both sides of canoe under rail, done in best Gold Bronze, edged with color, \$2.00; plain \$1.50; Gold Leaf, edged, \$3.50; plain, \$3.00.

Canoes having mahogany outwales with inwale stained to match, \$2.00 extra; with outwales and inwales mahogany, \$4.50 extra. The wales is the wood work at the top edge of the boat. Canoes with 24 inch mahogany deck finished with a combing, \$7.00 extra.

The above additions are only necessary to make a special style of finish and grand appearance and is not necessary in the regular high grade canoe.

The above price includes the regular High Grade Morris Canoe, with white spruce rails, mahogany decks, seats and braces, cane seats, 15 in. decks. For price of canoe, including one pair of best paddles or one pair of mahogany back rests, add \$2.50 to list.

If a keel is desired, it should be specified in your order, as all canoes are not finished with keels.

Special Indian Model

The Special Indian Model herein illustrated is a very popular canoe. And one that is giving perfect satisfaction as a safe and practical boat. Its lines and general appearance are very graceful. It is extremely staunch for a craft of its dimensions, and is designed for comfort, safety and a very nice running canoe, adapted to various uses, such as, clubs, livery men, hunting, fishing and cruising. It is a fine model on shallow and quick water, due to its large carrying capacity on slight draft.

The materials used in the regular High Grade Morris Canoes are as follow:— The ribs and planking or siding are of the finest quality of cedar, the rails are made of clear, straight grained spruce, the decks, seats and braces are mahogany. All seats cane filled.

Model For Speed

No. 93, 94 and 95 lengths, 16, 17 and 18 feet, beam 30 inches, depth 11 inches, price and style of finish same as high grade Special Indian Model. This model has very little tumble home, has good lines for speed, is very graceful in appearance and has given perfect satisfaction as a speedy canoe. It is quite safe with proper handling, but is built for speed rather than safety.

These canoes are built for use where extra fine finish is not required. Although they are not highly finished, they are well finished and constructed most thoroughly. The materials used in them are the same as in the highest grade, with the exception of the seats, decks and braces, which are made of oak. Seats are cane filled. First quality paddles, \$1.25 each, if ordered with canoe.

Price of the above canoes, finished in this style is \$35.00 for either length, 15-16-17 or 18 feet.

The bottom board or grating in my canoes is made of thin spruce slats and is removable by turning four buttons.
